GENERAL EXPLANATIONS ABOUT ASTROLOGICAL INTERPRETATION

Astrology can enlighten our behavior and clarify correlations in life. However, it can't and shouldn't pin a person down. An astrological birth picture consists of symbols that have been translated into words and concrete examples in the following text. For the sake of clarity, some examples have been exaggerated.

What astrology has to say can be explained by using examples. You have different aspects of your personality like your will, feelings, rational mind, etc. Imagine these to be actors who are staging the play of "life" together. Astrology describes the actors, their qualities and weaknesses, and their relationships with each other. But astrology has little to say about the play that is being acted. You decide this with your free will.

Experienced actors to whom you can constantly give new stage directions are necessary for a good play. The more you know the needs of your actors, the more you can bring them together into a harmonious and unified "play" and let them express themselves on your life's stage. The following pages will be a guide for doing this.

When reading them, you will discover contradictions. For example: one section describes the need for a calm and stable relationship, and another section says that you need stimulation and variety within a relationship. Such a contradiction contains the demanding challenge to express both opposites.

The following text is not a "fortune-telling horoscope" because you alone are the architect of your own destiny. The horoscope describes the "raw material" that you have available.

APPEARANCE

The Ascendent symbolizes the "display window" or the "mask" of your personality, which means the qualities that you primarily exhibit to the outside world and other people initially perceive in you. It indicates an area with which you are familiar on the one hand, but challenges you throughout your lifetime to intensively develop your personality on the other hand.

Ascendent in Scorpio

A Mysterious and Enigmatic Exterior

With the Ascendent in Scorpio, you make a mysterious and profound impression on your fellow human beings. You don't show your hand without good reason, but can quite quickly see through others. There is something searching and ponderous about your behavior. Other people may react to this with caution. Life challenges you repeatedly to not only show intensity, commitment, toughness, and the willingness to completely get involved in something as a "mask" to the outside world but also let these attributes become your inner qualities. By more or less playing the role of the person who is searching and able to endure things, you will also bring light into the dark and unknown chambers of your soul. With the passing years, you will develop a penetrating glance that can see behind the surface of yourself, other people, and things in general.

The Ascendent is like a pair of glasses through which you can perceive the surrounding world with a special hue You want to uncover the causes and correlations and cannot help but ask what the reasons are for every situation. Anything that isn't visible or apparent fascinates you. For example, you have no problem with taking something apart in order to see what is inside, even if this destroys it. You go all out, with endurance and passion, in both positive and negative situations.

Just as the Sun is the central star of the solar system in astronomical terms, it also symbolizes the essential nature of a human being in astrology. Its position in the birth picture tells us something about our ego-consciousness, about our will and the way in which we shape our lives.

Sun in Libra

The Path in Life as a Stylish Work of Art

In your innermost being, you strive for justice, harmony, and peace. Your tactful and affable manner lets you be popular with many people. Getting rid of conflicts is one of your concerns. In doing so, you can develop considerable diplomatic abilities if you face the conflict and don't simply conform for the sake of peace. You are good at approaching other people. At the same time, you always emphasize what you have in common and what connects you with them. You often pay too little attention to the differences. In your endeavor to have the other person like you, you shy away from clearly expressing your own opinion and conform too frequently. You have a hard time making decisions. Or you have taken on the role of an outsider or rebel. Perhaps you hold completely different views than the rest of your family. Or you move frequently, rearrange the furniture, or give your home furnishings an original, possibly even eccentric touch. The common factor of these examples is the unrest that you bring into your private life.

This always involves the experience of not letting an emotional sense of security and a "warm nest" become rigid because of comfort but providing for change through a "fresh wind." A new situation brings new perceptions. By experimenting with your need for a sense of security, you will experience more and more of what you really need.

THE LONGING FOR LIBERATION AND DEVOTION
